Please read the following carefully and bring this form with you to your appointment.

Before Your Appointment

Follow your physician's specific instructions and guidelines to prepare appropriately for your procedure.

One week prior to your appointment, ask your doctor if you must have one of the following tests before your Endoscopy:

_____ EKG (Electrocardiogram)

_____ Laboratory test(s)

If an EKG or Lab test is required for your procedure and not completed before your Endoscopy appointment, your Endoscopy start time may be delayed. The above selected tests can be performed in our Out-Patient Laboratory with a physician's order. You must complete registration prior to any testing.

Arrival Time

We recommend arriving 90 minutes prior to your scheduled procedure time. Please note that arriving late may result in your appointment being moved to next available slot.

Transportation

For your safety, all patients are required to have a responsible driver (family or friend) to drive them home. Please note, no taxi/Uber/Lyft or public transportation is allowed. Your appointment will be rescheduled or cancelled if a driver is not available to take you home.

Registration

Registration is in the AdventHealth Medical Plaza, 3rd Floor, Room 370. The Medical Plaza is connected to the King Street (P3) parking garage.

- From the King Street parking garage 3rd Floor entrance: turn left.
- From parking lot elevators: turn right.
- Room 370 is located next to the King Street Café.

Appointment Checklist

- Bring your driver's license
- Bring your health insurance card
- Bring your completed personal history form (attached)
- Bring your completed medication and herbal supplements worksheet (attached)
- If you have a pacemaker or defibrillator, please bring your cardiology report.
- Arrive 90 minutes before scheduled endoscopy appointment
- Park in King Street Parking Garage (Please see back page for maps and directions)
- Arrange for transportation home

Directions

- From I-4, take Exit 85. Turn East onto E. Princeton Street.
- At the 2nd traffic light, turn Left onto Orange Avenue.
- At the 3rd traffic light, turn Right onto King Street.
- Parking is available in the King Street Parking Garage located on the right.

For your convenience, please park in the King Street parking garage (P3).

Patient drop-off and pick-up is on the 3rd floor of the King Street Parking Garage (P3). Please allow at least 15 minutes for parking.

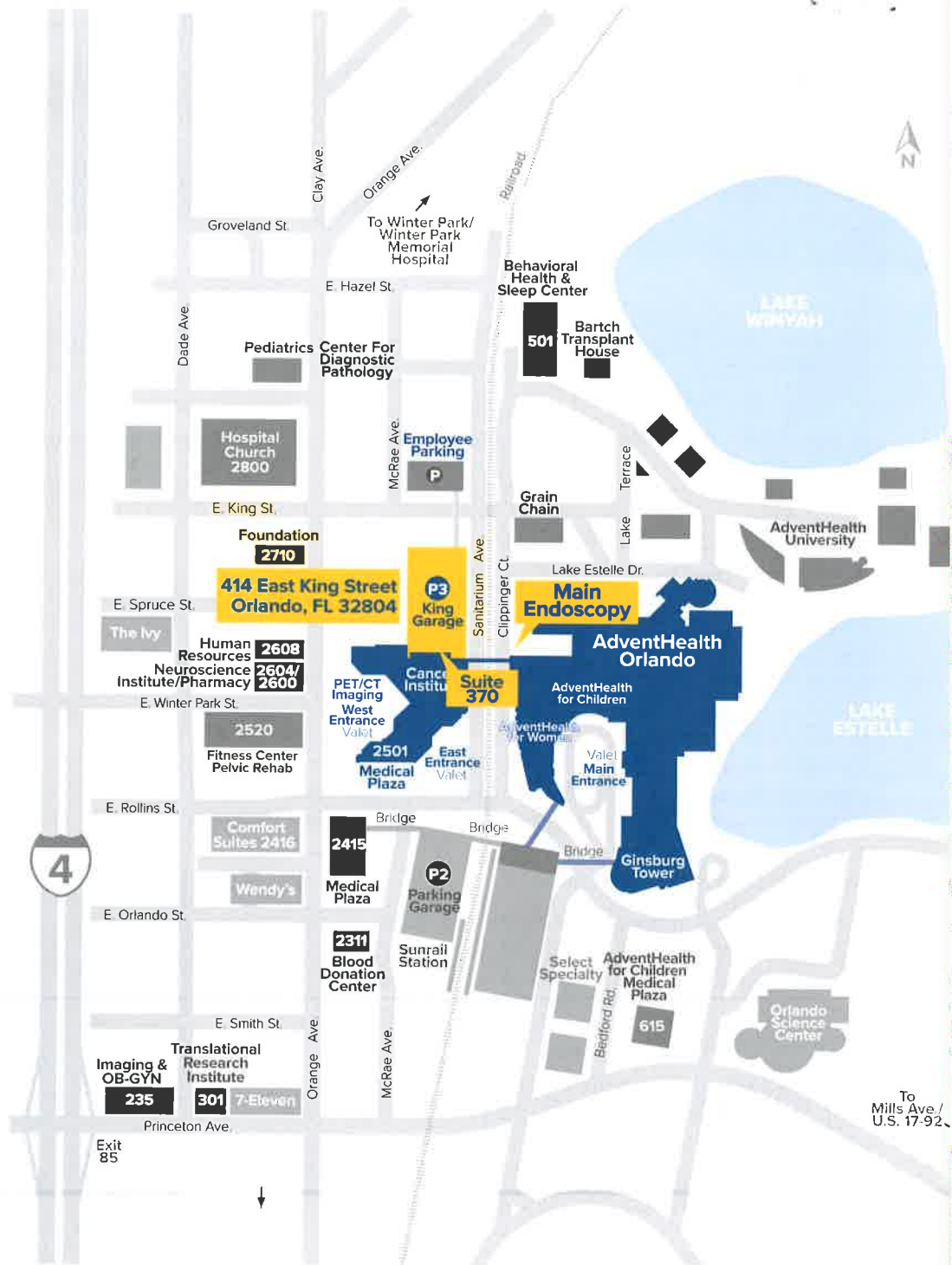
Registration

What to Expect on the Day of Your Procedure



- Please arrive at your scheduled time. We welcome your questions and will do our very best to keep you and your family informed.
- When checking in at Suite 370, have your insurance card and a photo ID. If you have the Health History and Medication Form filled out, provide this to the endoscopy department upon arrival.
- You will receive a card with a case number. This will help family members keep track of your progress by viewing the tracking board in the waiting area.
- After you have been registered, you will go across the bridge to Main Endoscopy to check in. Your assigned nurse will escort you and one family member to Pre-Op.
- Please understand that you will be taken back according to your scheduled procedure time, not the time you arrived.
- Once in Pre-Op, you will be introduced to the clinical team and they will prepare you for the procedure.
- You will then be taken to the endoscopy procedure room. Procedures vary in time. Your nurse will provide a procedure time estimate.
- When the procedure is finished, you will be taken to the recovery area where your designated family member and the physician will join you.
- Once you are ready to go home, discharge instructions will be provided and you will be transported to your car.

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
